



## ***Colonial Golf & Tennis Club's Interclub Play Program***

**The Interclub Play Program (IPP) is a reciprocity agreement between 23 golf clubs in south central Pennsylvania. Full golf membership at Colonial Golf & Tennis Club gives access to twenty-two other local golf facilities. All of these reciprocal clubs can be played by members for a nominal fee.**

### **Program Guidelines**

- The base days of play are Tuesday through Friday each week. Some clubs may choose to allow afternoon play on the weekends when time permits.
- The program is restricted to full golfing members of participating clubs. Limited memberships, recreational memberships, or memberships with severely restricted golf privileges are not eligible.
- Member clubs may restrict admittance of member guests if needed. Associated clubs agree to accept two foursomes of IPP members per day when their schedules permit. Certain clubs may choose to accept more at their discretion.
- All reservations must be made through the Golf Shop Staff.
- The fee for play is \$30 and includes golf, cart, and practice range usage. The fee will be charged even if a player chooses to walk while playing another club.
- Many participating clubs require payment on-site for the reciprocal fee of \$30 per person, to avoid billing issues and delays. All traveling members should be prepared to pay the fee on-site via credit card or cash if requested by the hosting club.
- The program is designed for members of one participating club to be able to travel to another. Two sets of two golfers from participating clubs may also play on a participating course where that none are members. The decision to charge greens fees or the reciprocal rate will be left to the discretion of the host club.
- Members have the option of inviting outside guests to join them for play. The outside guest will be billed at the club's normal guest fees.
- Weekday starting times may be reserved one week in advance. For weekend play, please call no earlier than the Thursday before to secure a starting time.
- The dress code of the host club must be observed. Only soft or non-penetrating spikes are allowed.
- We encourage visiting members and guests to patronize dining services at any participating club they visit. When planning to have dinner at a club, make reservations when checking in at the Golf Shop.
